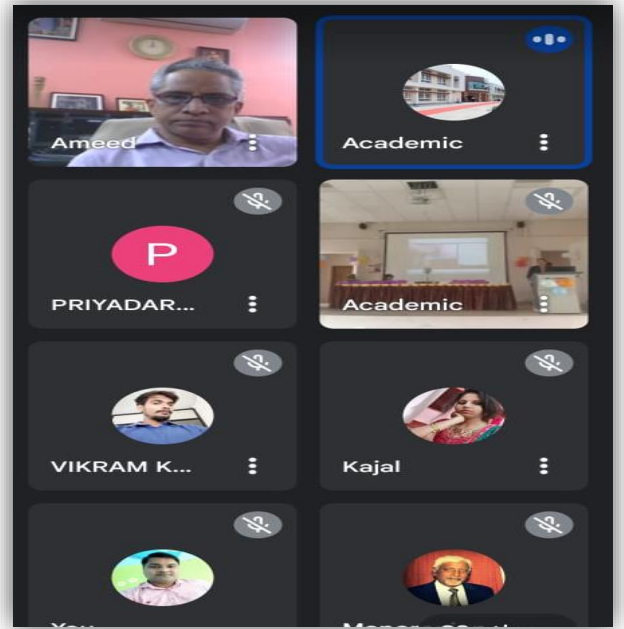

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Observance of the 2021 international day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD)



Since 1992, the International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD) has been annually observed on 3rd December around the world. Due to COVID-19 as per Government's guideline the program was organized through online mode. The special day program was organized by Composite Regional Centre for Skill development, Rehabilitation and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. The theme for 2021 IDPD is "Leadership & participants of persons with disabilities toward and inclusive and sustainable post COVID-19 world". As a part of program more than 50 special children participated in theme based paintings and Cultural event form Antar jyoti balika school (VI), Patna, other special schools and the children attending at CRC, Patna for rehabilitative Services..





The program started with Welcome note given by Ms. Priyadarshini, Officer - in- Charge, CRC Patna. Dr. Ameer Equebal, Director, National Institute for Locomotor Disability, Kolkata addressed with key note on the special day and emphasized on Early Interventions, importance of skill levels and also motivated all for Empowerment of persons with disabilities. The guest speakers **Mrs. Pinki Kumari**, Asst. Director, Directorate of Disability Empowerment, The Govt of Bihar and **Mr. Kantmanu Chaurasia**, RCI ZCC Member joined the day at the centre. They focused on invisible disabilities and discussed issues at present after post COVID-19 in facing physical and mental well beings of children with disabilities and their parents. The importance of empowerment of persons with disabilities and early intervention they mentioned in their speech. The pre recorded videos and some live performances through online were displayed based on variety of talents (i.e. **Song, Drawing, Dance, Speech**) of children with disabilities. On the day ADIP camp was also organized and aids and appliance distributed through ADIP scheme. The centre also organized some different competitions on the day.
